  - Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass requisite medical fitness test(s) conducted by the Railway Administration to ensure that the candidates are medically fit to carry out the duties connected with the post.

Recruitment to posts identified as suitable for persons with disabilities and reserved

accordingly will be undertaken by Chief Personnel Officer, Western Railway.

#### 4. PROSPECTS :

##### Salary And Other Benefits :

- The monthly emoluments on successful completion of training wherever applicable will be on the minimum of the scale of pay plus Dearness Allowance as admissible from time to time.
- In addition, the employee will get House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowance depending on the place of posting, as admissible.

##### Postings :

- Candidates recommended are liable to be posted anywhere on Western Railway. For posts where there is initial training, stipend will be paid as per the extant rules. The candidates selected will be absorbed after the training wherever prescribed. They will be considered in due course for promotion to higher grades according to rules/orders in force from time to time.

#### 5. TERRITORIAL ARMY :

All male candidates appointed are liable for active Territorial Army Services in Railway Engineering Units for such periods as laid down from time to time.

#### 6.0 HOW TO APPLY:

- Candidate should carefully read the instructions for filling the application form. Application (s) shall be made on good quality paper size of 30 cms. x 21 cms (A/4 Size)(80GSM Bond paper), using ONE SIDE ONLY and should be in conformity with the format given in this Notice. Candidates are advised to ensure that the application is legible, written in their own handwriting (English/Hindi) dated and signed. Candidates must use exact photo copy of the prescribed application format or may use full scale download copies from our website [www.rrbadi.org](http://www.rrbadi.org) on bond paper. Any deviation in application form as specified above may lead to the rejection of application of the candidates. The candidate should affix his/her normal signature in the application form. (Applications with signature in short form/capital letters/spaced out letters will be treated as invalid.)
- Details of Name, Father's name, Address, Nearest Railway station and Declaration should be in English only. Only international numerals i.e. 1,2,3 should be used.
- Photograph: One recent passport size black and white photograph with clear front view of the candidate in normal attire without cap/sunglasses/wigs (not earlier than one month of the date of application) should be pasted in the application in the space provided. One identical extra copy of the photograph firmly stitched to the Application Form indicating candidate's name and category No. applied for, on the reverse of each photograph. Candidates may note that the RRB may reject a candidate at any stage for pasting old/unclear photograph on the Application Form and for any significant variation between photograph pasted in the application and the actual physical appearance of the candidate.

6.4 Candidates applying for more than one post i.e. common category need to fill only one application for each group clearly indicating their order of preference of categories and posts applied for. The allotment of posts will be made depending on merit, vacancies available and preference of the candidates. However, RRB's decision in this respect will be final.

6.5 In Col. No.12 of the Application Form, to indicate marks of identification, candidates should indicate any two visible marks like a mole or a scar etc. Normally this should be same marks entered in the official identification documents such as School Leaving Certificate etc. Application without writing identification marks will be rejected.

6.6 It is important to note that the item no.10 of "INFORMATION DATA SHEET" (DECLARATION) should be copied out by the candidate in his/her own handwriting in the space provided below item no.10. (not in capitals/spaced out letters) failing which their application will be rejected.

6.7 Certificates showing proof of community should be enclosed with the application. Attested Xerox copies (not original) of the bonafide certificates issued from competent authorities not below the rank of Tahsildar in case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and OBC candidates. For OBC candidate, the certificate should not be more than one year old and must contain clause relating to creamy layer invariably. The certificate should necessarily contain religion, caste and bear the seal of the issuing authority. The xerox copies should be clear and legible and the signature, date, designation and seal of the attesting authority should be clearly visible, failing which the application will not be valid. The certificate if not in English/Hindi should be accompanied by attested translated (English/Hindi) copies.

6.8 Application should be submitted separately for each category (except combined category as specified). Candidates submitting more than one application for a category will be disqualified. If any such candidate gets selected inadvertently, he/she will not be offered appointment later on and is even liable to be debarred from RRB examination.

6.9 Candidates who wish to apply for more than one category should send separate postal order/DD for the prescribed value as well as a separate set of enclosures as required for each category in separate cover.

6.10 The cover (envelope) should be clearly superscribed in bold capitals 'APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF (Name of Post) CATEGORY No.\_\_\_\_, Employment Notice No.\_\_\_\_. If the post and category number is not indicated on the top of the envelope containing application, the same will not be entertained and treated as rejected.

6.11 The candidates should affix their Left Hand Thumb impression in the space provided in the Application Form. The impression should be clear and complete.

#### 7.0 ENCLOSURES:

The following enclosures should be attached along with the application:-

- Crossed IPO/DD for the amount as prescribed against each category should be firmly tied/annexed on top of the Application form.
- Attested Xerox copy of Caste certificate in the prescribed format as per the annexure 'I' and 'II'.
- No Objection Certificate in case of departmental candidates.
- Vision certificate (as per Annexure-III), in case of Assistant Loco Pilot only.
- One additional photograph apart from the one pasted on the application form.
- Ex-Serviceman applying for the post shall submit appropriate certificates issued by the services to claim educational standards.

#### 8.0 EXAMINATION FEES (NON REFUNDABLE):

8.1 Candidates are advised to see the details of fees to be paid in column no.14 mentioned against each category on first page in the table.

#### 8.2 Mode of Examination fee payment :

The examination fee is non-refundable. The examination fee should be paid in the form of Crossed Demand Draft from any Nationalised Bank or Indian Postal Order, drawn in favour of "Assistant Secretary, Railway Recruitment Board, Ahmedabad" payable at Ahmedabad. The candidates should write their Name, Address, Category Number and Employment Notice on the reverse of the Demand Draft/Postal Order. Validity of Demand Draft should be of six months. IPO/DD obtained earlier to the date of issue of the Employment Notice or after the closing date will not be accepted.

#### 9.0 AGE:

9.1 The lower and upper age limits are indicated in column no. 4 The age will be reckoned as on 01.01.2007

9.2 Special age relaxation is available to some groups of candidates as indicated below. Candidates desirous of availing age relaxation should indicate the corresponding code in the application form in the space provided. Documentary proof should also be enclosed.

9.3 Upper age limit in case of course completed Act Apprentice applying for categories where ITI/Act Apprenticeship is an essential qualification, shall be relaxed to the extent of apprentice training undergone under Apprentice Act 1961

9.4 No age relaxation is allowed to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying against un-reserved posts.

#### 10.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS & PROCESS OF RECRUITMENT :

10.1 After scrutiny of the applications, RRB will issue Call letters for Written examination to provisional eligible applicant indicating the time, date and venue. The Cities/Towns where the written examinations are to be held will be as per the administrative convenience of RRB/Ahmedabad. No change of Time, Date, Centre of Examination will be entertained on any account.

10.2 The RRB reserves the right to conduct examination for multiple categories on the same day and time. The examination may be held for the same posts in more than one RRB on the same day.

10.3 Free Second class Railway pass from the nearest Railway station to the place of written examination will be issued to the candidates belonging to SC/ST categories only. All the other candidates will have to bear expenses for appearing in the written examination, interview and verification etc.

10.4 Syllabus: The written examination will be in conformity with the educational standards prescribed for the post. It will consist of multiple choice objective type questions covering proficiency in Language (Hindi/English), Mathematics, General Knowledge, Reasoning and Professional/Technical knowledge in the related subjects. Question paper will be generally be bi-lingual i.e. English/Hindi. There shall be negative marks for wrong answers at the rate of 1/3rd of allotted marks to each questions. Depending upon the number of vacancies, candidates who qualify in the written examination and satisfy the eligibility criteria upto the required number will be advised regarding further selection. 1.2 times the vacancies, the candidates will be called for the Document Verification.

10.5 Verification : Finally, the candidates will be called in the office of RRB for verification of all original certificates and counselling before recommending them for appointment.

10.6 Final selection will be based on the results of written examination, 2nd stage written examination, interview, skill test, Typing skill test, Aptitude test, Vision test wherever applicable, verification of Original document during counselling.

10.7 Panel : A panel of successful candidates will be recommended to the Railway Administration (CPO/DPO's Office), who in turn will verify all original documents and issue offer of Appointment subject to the candidate fulfilling all the criteria including medical standards against vacancies.

10.8 Mere selection of candidates or recommendation of his/her name by the RRB or offer of Appointment does not confer any right on the candidate for his/her appointment in Railways.

10.9 The number of vacancies indicated is provisional and may be enhanced or reduced or even made 'Nil' depending upon the actual needs of the Administration. The administration also reserves the right to cancel all notified vacancies at its discretion and such decision will be final and binding on all. In the event of cancellation of the notified vacancies, the examination fee/postal charges paid by the candidates will not be refunded.

#### 11.0 SPECIAL CONDITION OF RECRUITMENT :

11.1 Before applying for the post the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills the eligibility norms for the post. The candidates should have the requisite minimum educational/Technical qualifications from the recognised university/ Institutions on the date of submitting application. Those awaiting results of the final examination or the qualifying certificates need not apply.

11.2 Candidates must ensure that spellings of their name, father's name and other particulars filled in the application form should be strictly in conformity with the original certificates.

11.3 For category nos. 20 to 30 candidates holding Diploma /Degree in Engineering need not apply (in lieu of ITI).

11.4 RRB reserves the right to reject the candidature of any applicant at any stage of recruitment process if the candidate is found ineligible for the post for which he/she has applied or indulges in any form of malpractice. Services of such ineligible candidates are also liable to be terminated even if appointed inadvertently.

11.5 RRB reserves the right to conduct additional written examination/ second stage examination/ skilled test/ interviews/ re-examination/ verification at any stage of recruitment for any specific category RRB may hold re-test in any category for specific number of candidates at any stage. RRB also reserves the right to cancel part or whole of any recruitment process at any stage for any of the categories notified without assigning any reason thereof, if warranted due to Administrative reason.

11.6 RRB may conduct on-line examination in respect of any category of post. Candidates should be ready to appear in on-line test for which advance intimation shall be given.

11.7 Various information data, terms and conditions mentioned in the Employment notice are liable to change due to Government or Judicial Order or by Railway Board made subsequently.

11.8 The Candidates who have been debarred from all RRB examinations and the period of debarment still not completed need not apply. Their applications will be rejected.

11.9 Ladies are also eligible for all posts. They may however, note that the nature of duties may involve outdoor/shift working.

11.10 Caste once filled as SC/ST/OBC in Application form will not be allowed to be changed subsequently.

11.11 Any material suppression of facts or submitting forged caste certificates by a candidate for securing eligibility and/or obtaining privileges including free travel for appearing in the examination shall be liable not only for rejection of his/her candidature for the particular Recruitment for which he/she has applied, but he/she will also be debarred from all examinations conducted by all RRB's all over the country, for a period of two years and legal action will be taken wherever warranted.

11.12 Candidates found adopting unfair means in the examination or deputing someone else for appearing in the examination in their place will be debarred from all the RRB's for lifetime. Such candidates will also be prosecuted by lodging FIR.

#### 12.0 GROUND FOR REJECTION OF APPLICATION:

The Application having following deficiencies, defect and irregularities are liable to be treated as invalid and rejected summarily without any intimation to the candidate:

- Applications not in the prescribed format as mentioned in the Notification. (Candidates purchasing Application Form from the market should ensure that it meets the requirement of format)
- Applications which are incomplete and/ or illegible.
- Applications from underaged/overaged candidates.
- More than one application for same category.
- Applications not filled in by the candidate in his/her own hand writing.
- Applications filled in a language other than Hindi/English.
- Applications received after closing date and time.
- Applications which are unsigned/undated or Application signed in block letters/capital letters.
- Applications submitted without enclosing proper Caste certificate in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- Applications without necessary certificate in proof in respect of ES candidates.
- Application of candidates not possessing the prescribed educational/technical qualification at the time of submitting application.
- Applications without proper and specified amount of Examination Fees.
- Applications without declaration / incomplete declaration / declaration not in running hand.
- Application made on Newspaper cuttings.
- Applications without left thumb impression/identification mark of candidate.
- Application without enclosing medical certificate as per Annexure-III in case of Asst. Loco Pilot.
- Candidates who are under debarment period of any RRB.
- Application not addressed to RRB-Ahmedabad.
- Application without pasted photograph.
- Applications which in the opinion of RRB do not comply any of the instructions and /or conditions mentioned in this notification or found deficient in any respect are liable to be rejected at any stage.

#### 13.0 EX-SERVICEMEN CANDIDATES:

The term Ex-servicemen means a person, who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as non-combatant) in the regular Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Reserve Engineering force, the Lok Sahayak Sena and the Para Military forces: and (a) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension or (b) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension or (c) who has been released otherwise than on his own request from such service as a result of reduction in such establishment or (d) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement otherwise than on his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories.

- Pension holders for continuous embodied service.
- Pensioners with disabilities attributable to military service and
- Gallantry award winners.

d) Explanation : The persons serving in the armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service would come under the category of Ex-Servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specific terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to the Ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the Uniform until they complete the specified terms of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union. Service Personnel who are to be discharged from military service on or before 01/10/2007 are eligible to apply for this Notice.

13.1 Ex-Servicemen candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Government in Group C/ D will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for Ex-Servicemen of securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group C/D under Central Govt. However such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation for Ex-Servicemen in Central Govt. Jobs.

13.2 Matriculate Ex-Servicemen with 15 years of active service in armed Forces will be considered eligible to apply for the posts for which minimum qualification is a University Degree provided the relevant certificate issued by the Military authority is attached with the application. Sons/Daughter/Wards of Ex-Servicemen are not eligible to apply for the posts reserved for Ex-Servicemen.

13.3 For Apprentice categories the upper age limit with relaxation should not exceed 40 years for Ex-Servicemen candidates.
